Environmental Education is a program of great value to Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve.

For several years the Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserva has been working with five schools adjacent to the Monteverde district, especially in the catchment area of Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve.

The schools are: Escuela Monte los Olivos, Escuela las Nubes, Escuela la Cruz, Escuela Canitas y Escuela Los Tornos. The

program includes visits to schools by the program manager and his students were to visit the reserve.

During the Children's Day celebration was a visit by students from the School La Cruz to Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve. This was also supported by collaborators and naturalist guides at Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve. Thanks to them they gave students a short guided hike through one of the trails in Santa Elena Cloud Forest Reserve. The guided hike was accompanied by a brief talk on the cloud forest and some of its wonders.





During the visit, students had the opportunity to observe some insects, birds and learn details of the forest. Importantly, this year the focus is solid waste management, so that the topics to be discussed during the visit were focused on the matter.
